

TREE No 1a - MICKLETHWAIT ORIGINALLY FROM CAWTHORNE /
 INGBIRCHWORTH & THEN FROM CIRCA 1650 SWINE IN
 HOLDERNESS & ARDSLEY IN BARNESLEY, YORKSHIRE,
 ENGLAND.

In early medieval records there are several Micklethwait families - one which appears to have survived the
 Black Death is shown in the 1279 Poll Tax Records as being at Cawthorne & Ingbirchworth West
 Yorkshire.

The Inquisitions Post Mortem records (1226 - 1432) for the county of Yorkshire refer to members of the family.

In Gorthwaite deeds, there is reference to three generations of Micklethwaits before the time of Edward 1. (1272-1307).
